

White House LGBT Conference on HIV/AIDS

The White House LGBT Conference on HIV/AIDS was held April 19 in Atlanta, according to a White House statement. Hosted by the White House Office of Public Engagement and the Office of National AIDS Policy (ONAP), in partnership with the Morehouse School of Medicine, the conference offered policy updates from senior administration officials—featuring Grant Colfax, MD, the new ONAP director—as well as workshop sessions covering federal health resources available to LGBT people with HIV. It was part of a series of LGBT-related conferences by the White House this year.
