

amfAR Gives Over \$100,000 to MSM HIV Groups in Africa

Seven groups in Africa that work with men who have sex with men (MSM) and transgender people have been awarded HIV-related grants from amfAR, The Foundation for AIDS Research, according to an amfAR statement. Each organization will receive \$10,000 to \$20,000 to fund HIV prevention, testing, treatment and advocacy efforts. Most of the groups are based in countries where same-sex sexual relations, especially among men, are illegal.
