

Magic Johnson on Living With HIV, Homophobia in Hip-Hop

Magic Johnson is developing a campaign to fight HIV/AIDS by combating homophobia in hip-hop, The *Huffington Post* reports. He revealed plans for the campaign in a wide-ranging interview with *HuffPost* reflecting on the 20 years since he announced he was living with HIV and would retire from professional basketball. Johnson said he wanted to rally the hip-hop community to help deliver HIV/AIDS awareness to young people. He also said he intends to include basketball players and football players in the campaign. No date yet has been set for a formal announcement of the campaign.
