“All faith traditions include exhortations to honor the dignity and worth of every person and care for the sick, poor, and needy,” [write the organizers on FaithAIDSDay.com](#). “While many faith traditions may include laws and teachings forbidding traditionally stigmatized behaviors such as extramarital sex and substance use that can put people at risk for acquiring HIV, most faiths also emphasize forgiveness, mercy, and grace in reconciling human frailty with religious and spiritual teachings.”
