I didn't even know I had fibroids.

I knew I hurt constantly and finally went to an ob-gyn someone recommended. They did exploratory surgery and said I had endometriosis. I was told they removed all of the endometrial tissue.

Afterwards, I didn't feel better. In fact, after about a year, my periods started getting longer and heavier. This went on for several months. One day at work, my left arm hurt and was going numb, and I was short of breath. I went to see a doctor that day. I had an EKG and it was abnormal. I was sent for more testing and found out I'd lost so much blood and it had gone on for so long that I had congestive heart failure.

I had to have a transfusion and I now have a pacemaker and defibrillator. I'm now partially disabled due to my heart issues; all because of fibroids.

I had a D&C and then the following month I had a hysterectomy. I wish they would have done the hysterectomy years before. I had constant cramping and pain for probably 10 years or more.

If your doctor won't listen, then find one that will. Fibroids are nothing to mess with.
